Through all these equipment donations there have been countless stories of the need and impact of the work: heartache of hearing the story of two sisters sharing a single sports bra; motivation as the recession and pandemic impacted our most vulnerable families the hardest; joy when youth we serve go on to achieve academic success and head off to college.
